Equal Pay Customers, Please Take Note...

Your equal pay monthly utility amount is reevaluated/recalculated every January & July of each year. That monthly equal pay amount may go up or go down depending on the previous 12-month usage of utility services.

Cross Connection surveys have been mailed to all BPW -Auburn water customers. These surveys are required by the Department of Health and Human Services as part of our permit to operate a Water System. Every water service is required to complete one of these surveys every five years. Enough cannot be said about how quickly a cross connection can occur and cause harm to humans and animals. Completing and returning the form fulfills the requirement and will help us keep your water safe!

TOP 10 WATER SAFETY TIPS

1. Always supervise children in and around the water
2. Never swim alone
3. Don't dive or jump into water that you can't see through
4. Never turn your back to the ocean
5. Don't depend on floating toys to keep you safe
6. Children and non-swimmers should always wear life jackets in open water
7. Don't prolong the time you hold your breath underwater
8. Swim only in designated swim areas
9. Don't leave toys or other floatables in an unsupervised pool
10. Learn to swim
